
July 20, 2015 - *Refuge* First Novel in Anticipated Vampire/Christian Fiction Trilogy

Refuge is the debut novel of author Jason K Macomson, of Lavonia, Georgia, and was published May 24, 2015. This new book is an exciting story of Christian Fiction for young adults and adults that frames the good news of the Gospel in the context of vampire fiction. *Refuge* explores mature themes of faith, grace, providence, sacrifice, and family. The story contains no language or sex, and violence is understated and non-gratuitous. The message of the novel is firmly anchored in the Christian faith and reinforces the centrality of Jesus Christ. *Refuge* is the first of three novels in an anticipated trilogy, and is self-published by the author and distributed by Lulu Press, Inc.

About *Refuge*...

While visiting a reclusive aunt in the mountains of Western Maine, Carol is stranded at night on a desolate road after an automobile accident. When she sets out alone to search for help, she finds herself stalked by vampires and then rescued by an unlikely pair of vampire hunters. Eric and Will are not what they seem at first, though, and Carol is unsure if they are really her heroes or if something more sinister lies behind their actions. Over the next three days, the trio is forced on the run from murderous vampires, and Carol slowly learns the truth about both Will and Eric. Questioning everything she thought she ever knew about the nature of good and evil, Carol must confront difficult questions about the existence of God and where she will spend eternity. When she is captured by the local vampire coven, she faces a life and death choice, and Will and Eric must risk everything in an attempt to save her life.

Jason K Macomson is a practicing veterinarian and former public school teacher/administrator who lives in Lavonia, Georgia. He graduated from the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine in 1998, and went on to practice veterinary medicine locally at Lavonia Animal Hospital as well as teach at Franklin County High School. After teaching high school science for seven years (physics, chemistry, biology, and anatomy), he became a middle school administrator at

Franklin County Middle School for five years before returning to full-time veterinary practice in 2012. Currently he writes in his spare time but hopes to make writing a much bigger part of his life in the future. Although he has written a lot of literature and even country music songs in the past, *Refuge* is his first published work. Dr. Macomson owns a small farm and raises German Shorthaired Pointers. He also has one other dog, Tippy, and a cat, Ms. Kitty. When he is not busy working or writing, he enjoys fishing, biking, reading, and learning new languages. He practices mostly small animal medicine at a local veterinary practice, and coupled with his experience teaching young adults, his veterinary work has provided him with a rich background of experiences to draw upon as a source of inspiration for his novels.
